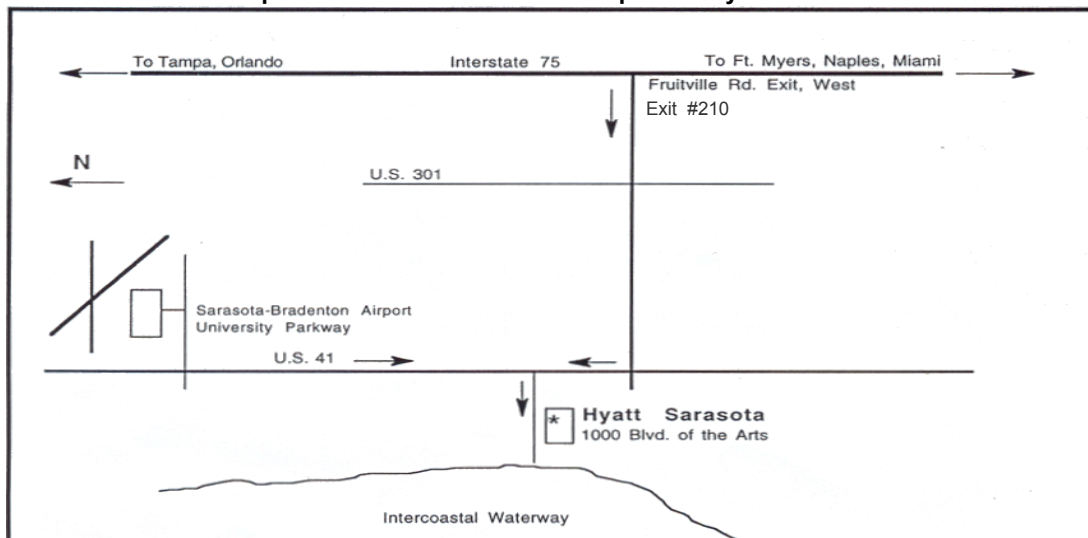
**WEEKLY AND MONTHLY EVENTS DOWNTOWN**
